## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PUPILS TRANSPORTED IN SCHOOL BUSES

1. All pupils shall be ready in the morning at the usual time for the bus to arrive at their homes or at the "School Bus Stop". The bus cannot wait for those who are tardy.
2. The driver is in full charge of the bus and the pupils.
3. Do not stand in the roadway while waiting for the bus. Do not cross the road in front of the bus until the bus has completely stopped.
4. If the driver wishes, he/she may assign seats in the bus and pupils will take the seats assigned.
5. Damage done to seats or other equipment must be paid for by the pupil or parents.
6. See that your conversation is clean and never loud nor boisterous. No swearing, rude gestures, or teasing.
7. Always treat your fellow passengers with courtesy.
8. In leaving the bus, remain seated until the bus stops. If you cross the road, do so in front of the bus after making sure the highway is clear.
9. No pupils will leave the bus without the driver's consent except at home and at school. The driver's consent will be given only with written authorization from the principal or parents.
10. Pupils shall help in keeping the bus clean. Place all paper or other refuse in proper containers.
11. There will be no eating, drinking, chewing tobacco, nor smoking on the school bus.
12. When the bus is in motion, do not stand, extend arms out of windows, or move from seat to seat.
13. The right of the pupils to ride in the bus is conditioned on their behavior and observance of these rules. Drivers are authorized to enforce these rules and make other suggestions in line with good citizenship.
