School Nutrition Program CHARGING

1. Meals must always be provided to grades K-4. Meals must also be provided to any students with disabilities who may be unable to take full responsibility for debt they have incurred.

2. Charging

- Grade 5-8 after 3 occurrences of charging within the school year a student may be given an alternate meal.
- Grade 9-12 no charging
- Adults no charging
- A-la-carte no charging
- 3. If a check is returned for insufficient funds, then the district will accept only cash for the rest of the school year.
- 4. No student will go hungry an alternate meal consisting of sandwich, milk and fruit and vegetable will be provided for all students
