

School Nutrition Program
CHARGING

1. Meals must always be provided to grades K-4. Meals must also be provided to any students with disabilities who may be unable to take full responsibility for debt they have incurred.

2. Charging

- Grade 5-8 after 3 occurrences of charging within the school year a student may be given an alternate meal.
- Grade 9-12 no charging
- Adults no charging
- A-la-carte no charging

3. If a check is returned for insufficient funds, then the district will accept only cash for the rest of the school year.

4. No student will go hungry an alternate meal consisting of sandwich, milk and fruit and vegetable will be provided for all students
