shall be established in a school is necessary for open and effective communication between a principal and his staff.

Meetings of the faculty committee, with the principal may be held at least once a month during the school year. The size of the various schools would have a bearing on the activities of this committee.

For the faculty committee to function effectively, its recommendations must be given due consideration in decisions that are made. The principal, by virtue of his position, has the ultimate

responsibility for administration of the school.
