

Health Examination

The superintendent may recommend employees for health examinations at any time if he/she has reason to believe that the health of the employee is detrimental to the welfare of pupils or other employees.

Tuberculosis Tests

Each employee shall file with the office of the superintendent a certificate showing that he/she is free from active tuberculosis. The expense of examinations to determine freedom of employees from active tuberculosis will be with the school nurse administering an intermittent test at school district expense. When an employee needs an x-ray examination, it will be at the employee's expense. A person whose previous employment was in another school in the state may transfer his or her certificate to this office and need not undergo a new test or x-ray.
