

Teacher Duties

A. The Board asserts that a teacher's primary purpose is the educational welfare of the pupil. The Board recognizes that a teacher is a professional and the Board will attempt to use a teacher in a fashion that uses these qualities wherever possible. The Board will make every effort to provide for help to assist a teacher in the carrying out of these non-professional tasks.

B. Chaperoning and other duties beyond the limits of the regular student school day which are not related to the teacher's assignment or non-teaching assignment and which are not covered by paid differentials shall be voluntary if possible. The principal shall make every effort to secure the voluntary assistance of teachers and/or parents to supervise and chaperone extra curricular activities. If the voluntary assistance of teachers and/or parents is not available, the principal shall assign staff members on the basis of a fair and impartial rotation schedule mutually agreed upon by the principal and the Association. Nothing in this article should be construed to allow a scheduled activity to be cancelled because volunteer teachers and/or parents are not available.
