

Materials Fees

In keeping with the establishment of free public schools, by law in our state, all necessary elements of any school activity in this school district, any integral fundamental part of elementary and secondary education, shall be provided free of charge to students. All qualified children shall be entitled to enroll and attend our schools, without payment of any fees, or purchase of any books, supplies or equipment associated with any aspect of the curriculum or other recognized school activity.

Students will be held responsible for the cost of materials of projects made, if they wish to retain said projects as well as for the depreciated cost of replacing any materials or property which are lost or damaged through their negligence.

The board will make every effort to provide all instructional equipment, books, materials, services, and activities needed to maintain the instruction program so that students, parents and other interested groups need not pay fees or engage in fund raising activities.

This policy is not intended to discourage acts of generosity on the part of any individual or group in making gifts to the school consistent with the board's policy on gifts, grants, and bequests.
