

## Nonresidents

Nonresident students may be accepted as tuition students in the schools under the following conditions:

1. Space is available and an appropriate program can be provided.
2. Admission is subject to review of the educational records and administration of appropriate educational, physical, psychological and psychiatric examinations.
3. Payment of tuition that is set annually by the board.
4. Transportation will not be provided if the student lives outside the district.
5. Admission is probationary, subject to periodic review, and must be re-approved annually.
6. Subject to the qualifications in 1, 2, 4, and 5 above, students who are residents of nations other than the United States may be admitted without payment of tuition under recognized foreign student exchange programs in which students are accepted on an equivalent basis in foreign countries.
7. No other nonresident students will be admitted without tuition.
