Pregnancy/Parenting

Appropriate special education and/or supportive assistance, such as hospital or homebound instruction, may be provided to pregnant students by the Pupil Evaluation Team if recommended

and approved by the superintendent of schools.

In these cases, it is estimated that the special education or supportive assistance will be required for 60 calendar days or less if this is the case, no individual educational program need be written, although all other Pupil Evaluation Team Procedures, records and notifications must be completed.

If, due to unforeseen factors, the period of service exceeds 60 calendar days, an I.E.P. shall immediately be written, containing information on the services already provided and their continuation.

Particular care shall be exercised by PET members in dealing with pregnant students to safeguard the student's right of privacy and confidentiality. Such expeditiously as possible after referral.
