

Relations Between Nonpublic and Other Educational Organizations and the Schools

The board will cooperate with parochial and private schools in matters of mutual benefit where not expressly prohibited by law.

The superintendent is encouraged to explore areas of mutual benefit with the administrative officers of such schools and to recommend desirable courses of action.

Relations with Parochial and Private Schools

In recognition of the educational, cultural, and economic values that parochial and private schools provide to the parents, citizens, and taxpayers of the community, the board shall make available, within the limits of applicable federal and state restrictions, the full range of public school services to resident pupils of the community who attend parochial or private schools.
