This survey asks you to share feedback for each grade level in which you have a child. Also equally important is student input regarding this survey. The survey can be completed in the paper form (enclosed) or accessed on MSAD 59's Remote Learning Hub page. Parents only need to complete one parent survey per household. Junior high and high school are asked to complete two surveys(one being the student survey) and return to them to the school so that we may gather as much information as possible.

Our goal is to better understand how remote learning went for your child(ren) and family. We will use this feedback to continue to improve our framework, strengthening our support structures and better our overall communication. This survey information will provide us valuable insight on how to plan for how to best meet our students' needs during this challenging time.
