There is no cost for participants to attend this summer academy.

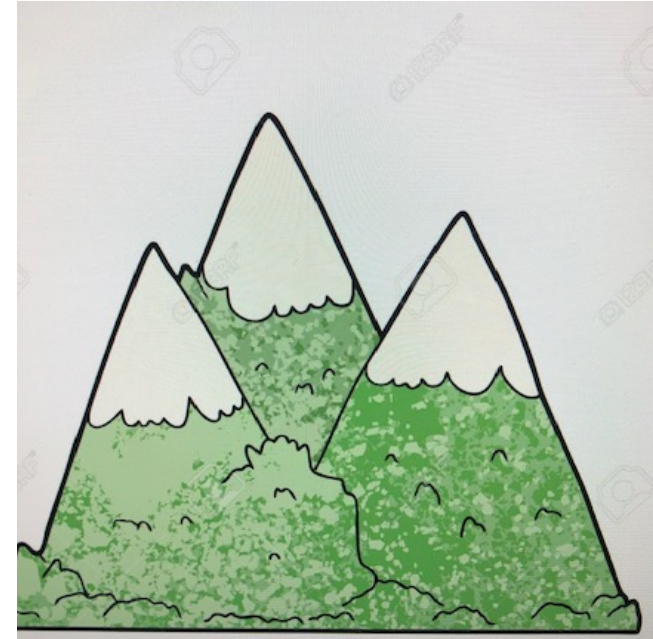

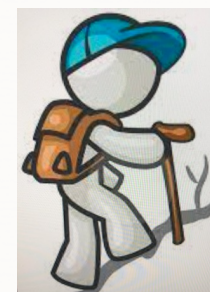
