Dear MHS Students and Parents,

Although the start to the 2020-2021 school year certainly looks much different than it has in the past, we are off to a great start. The change of going to a four block schedule has given our staff and students the time to create a more comprehensive learning environment especially during this chaotic time. We know that the unknown of what lies ahead creates a certain amount of anxiety but as always we truly appreciate your patience as we navigate through the school year.

Enclosed you will find a schedule for the month of October where you will see that we will be continuing the hybrid model. By now I am confident that most of our families have a good understanding of how this model works however we would like to clarify the process.

Hybrid Learning Students - Your student has been assigned to a specific day, either Lakewood or Kennebec in which they are required to be at school. On the opposite day students should be checking in remotely with the teacher for that block for the first ten minutes of class for attendance purposes and also to give students the chance to ask questions as needed.

Fully Remote Students – Your student has been assigned to a specific day, either Lakewood or Kennebec in which they are required to login and stay logged for in the entire class. On the opposite day students should be checking in remotely with the teacher for that block for the first ten minutes for attendance purposes and also to give students the chance to ask questions as needed.

We want to remind families that at this time guests are not permitted to enter the school which includes parents. If your child needs to be picked up early for any reason please call the main office at 696-3395 and we will send them out to you. If you need to pick up or drop off anything at school, we ask that you please utilize that table in the entry way of the school which has two bins that are appropriately labeled.
