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FULL REMOTE PLAN

It has been MSAD 59's focus to have our students in school for in-person education whenever it is safe to do so, but we know that there may be a time when we need to move a school or even the whole district to remote instruction. The district Full Remote Plan, is our learning plan should a building, or the entire district need to close and move to remote instruction. Since this summer MSAD 59 staff have worked to develop protocols for online learning that make sense. The FULL REMOTE PLAN is the next step in the process, and includes schedules for students in grades 5-8, should we need to move to remote learning.

FULL REMOTE PLAN

- A FULL REMOTE PLAN is used only when an entire school, or the entire district moves to remote learning.
- If a class, or grade level goes remote the students will follow their regular schedule.
- "Remote Learning" is nothing like what we did last Spring, it is organized and intentional, includes student schedules, and is designed to move learning forward for all students.
- Grades 5-8 student schedules/newsletters will continue to be sent home to parents each month.

What can parents/students do to be ready for remote learning in a FULL REMOTE PLAN?

- Post individual schedules in your home to be ready, save the links on your computer.
- Test your child's device when it comes home to be sure you can connect to the internet.
- Share this information with the person who will be working with your child if we are remote.
- If you have questions about the schedule, contact your child's teacher for clarification.
- If you have technology issues, please call our tech team who are available to support you from 7:45AM 3:00PM on any school day.

Daily Schedule

What you can do to help your child succeed remotely?

- Know that remote learning requires more student responsibility and family support than in-person learning.
- Help them find a space away from distractions. It is better if the space has a flat surface to work on and a seat.
- Make sure that they can connect to your home internet and if there is an issue, contact the building principal or the tech team.
- Make sure your child can connect to the teacher's Google classroom.
- Help them plan their day the night before. Review their schedule and what work needs to be completed.
- Check that they are completing and submitting assignments each day.
- Communicate with your child's teachers to ensure they are being successful.
- Put your child's password in a location that they can find.
- Reward your child's efforts and celebrate success!
